## The Ten Essentials

Any time a Scout goes on a camping trip or hike, he needs <u>be prepared</u> by carrying the following ten essential items in his pack. These essentials will allow a scout to survive in the outdoors in most emergency situations.

The ten essentials are:	
water bottle or canteen (with water in it!)	
extra food (trail mix works great)	
extra clothing ( <u>wool</u> sweater, fleece, or a parka)	
rain gear (a disposable poncho or garbage bag at minimum)	
first-aid kit (see <u>checklist</u> below)	
map and compass	
matches (in waterproof case) and fire starter (cotton or candle in film can)	
pocketknife	
sun protection (sunscreen and/or hat)	
flashlight with good batteries	
and of course there is the eleventh essential:	
toilet paper (in zip-lock plastic bag)	
First-aid Kit	The Outdoor Code

## Checklist for going camping or backpacking

<u>Individual Items</u> :
ten essentials (see ten essentials checklist) and toilet paper
backpack (duffel bag O.K. if car camping) and pack cover
sleeping Bag and pad (or air mattress)
ground cloth or bivouac sack (if no tent)
cup and bowl
spoon and fork
rope or 3mm cord (25 ft or more for bear and racoon bags)
extra socks
large plastic garbage bags (at least two)
soap (ivory, Dr. Bonners, or biodegradable)
small towel
toothbrush and toothpaste
scout handbook
long-sleeve shirt and windpants (or sweatpants)
swim suit (optional) and Tevas, boat shoes, or water socks (optional)
dark glasses (optional)
food bag (optional - but don't use your sleeping bag stuff sack to hang food in!)
group items (to be shared by two or more campers)
group first aid kit
tent (don't forget the items below)
poles tent stakes ground cloth (for tent)
cook gear (pots, spatula), stove, and (optional) brillo pad
water filter (remember they break) <u>and</u> Iodine tablets ( <i>Giardia</i> is everywhere)
trowel (vou'll need it for lathing duty)
